What to Bring

-Instrument/Music!

-Clothing - music shirt, dark pants/shorts, comfortable shoes...Dress Code Applies!

-Food - snacks/lunch on the bus (NO NUTS!) - no food brought into park

-Money - \$20/meal eaten at the park, any extra for souvenirs students may want

-Ipods/Cell Phones/Electronic Games - OK to use on bus, Cell Phones OK on bus/park. School/Park/Buses are not responsible for lost items!

-DVD's - OK for bus ride, must be PG rated

-Bags - OK in the park, students are responsible, not all rides have storage (items may be left on bus while at the park)

On the Bus

- Students encouraged to sleep!
- Try to keep noise down so we don't distract drivers
- Should* be Wifi/electric plugs - no guarantee
 - Bring portable charger for phone if possible!
- Eat lunch after performance/before Amusement park
- Students call home 30 minutes before arriving at Novi Middle School

At the Performance Schools

- Students are representing Novi - best behavior!
- When students are not performing/warming up, they sit in the audience - must be respectful of other performances.
- Students should have all belongings with them before leaving the schools

At the Park

- Once inside the park, everyone stays in the park unless they are with their TEACHER
- Mandatory check in times: 12:00, 2:30, 5:30, 8:45
- Awards ceremony (5:30) is mandatory
- Students will never be alone in the park - will always be with at least 2 other students (with at least 1 cell phone) or with their chaperone
- Students must be inclusive of all students in the group (don't leave anyone out!)

Medical Forms

Purple Form--On the bus medication. Given to you on your way into this meeting. Turn in TONIGHT.

Green Form--Controlled substances or medication NOT provided by the school. Available at the Medication table (Cafeteria). Due by Wednesday, 5/15.

Pink Form--Self-carry medication. Available at the Medication table (Cafeteria). Due by Wednesday, 5/15.

Medical Forms (continued)

TURN IN TONIGHT...

Purple Form = Non-prescription medication provided by the school (Ibuprofen, Tylenol, Tums, Benadryl, Dramamine, Claritin)

** Please check box if we have medical forms on file in the Attendance Office

DOCTOR SIGNATURE required for:

- Light Blue Form =
 - Controlled substances
 - Prescription meds
 - Any over-the-counter meds NOT provided on the bus.
- **This form is only for medication that the chaperone will possess

- Yellow Form = Self-carry meds (such as inhaler, EpiPen)
